

## Spiritual Gifts Defined

- 1) Gift of Apostleship:** Fifteen authoritative representatives sent out by Christ Himself to accomplish Christ's mission
- 2) Gift of Miracles:** The ability to break the laws of nature as a display of God's power
- 3) Gift of Healing:** The ability to supernaturally cure sickness or disability
- 4) Gift of Teaching:** The ability to understand, explain and apply the written revelation of God to the people of God
- 5) Gift of Prophecy:** Speaking an authoritative and infallible message revealed to you directly from God
- 6) Gift of Languages (Tongues):** The supernatural ability to speak in a language that you have never learned
- 7) Gift of Interpretation of Languages (Tongues):** The supernatural ability to interpret a language that you have never learned
- 8) The Gift of Serving:** Alertness to notice undone tasks in the ministry and empowerment to use the available resources to get the job done
- 9) The Gift of Helping:** Compassion to take a brother's problem as your own and fight for them for them
- 10) The Gift of Generosity:** Excitement to sacrificially give to the work of God, to help brothers in need, or just to be a blessing
- 11) The Gift of Mercy:** Having pity and willingly helping without expectation of earthly repayment
- 12) The Gift of the Word of Knowledge:** Supernatural insight about a person or situation revealed to you directly from God
- 13) The Gift of the Word of Wisdom:** Supernatural insight into the relationship between spiritual truths revealed to you directly from God
- 14) The Gift of Discerning Between Spirits:** The supernatural ability to tell the true source behind a message that someone claiming is from God
- 15) The Gift of Faith:** Supernatural confidence in God's power and promises resulting in endurance and living pleasing to God despite difficulties, opposition, or failures
- 16) The Gift of Exhortation:** Supernatural ability to come along side a brother, give hope and persuasively direct them on the path of obedience, progress & joy.
- 17) The Gift of Administration:** God given ability to direct & guide the church to accomplish God's goals
- 18) The Gift of Leadership:** Empowerment to model faithful & humble service that inspires others to follow your example and to join you in accomplishing God's work
