

## Discussion Guide for Hebrews 9:15-28

### Perfect Christ, Persevering Faith

- 1. Read Hebrews 9:15-28 and then briefly review the sermon outline.** (Outline review target time is five minutes or less.)

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear, or troubling?

- 2. Truth:** "Only the perfect Christ and his perfect work can ensure lasting faith in my life."

1. The author of Hebrews takes great pains to explain how everything about the new covenant (agreement) is better than the old. What are the old ways of life or "dead works" that have in the past or are now tempting you? How does the thought of the perfect sacrifice of Christ help us persevere in faith?
2. Take a moment to meditate on the thought that Christ is interceding for you, personally, and the group, before the Father, at this very moment. How should Christ's example change the way you think about other people and the frequency and intensity of your prayer for others?
3. God is "on high, yet He takes thought of the lowly." How should Christ's example as a humble high priest make our faith come alive? Are there "lowly" people in your life you have not fully embraced as brothers?
4. Take some time to meditate on the future aspects of your salvation. As a group, list at least 10 things that will be true of our life in glory with Christ when He returns. Are you eagerly awaiting Christ's return? Why or why not?

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
