1. Read John 11:45-53 and then briefly review the sermon outline.

- -How have you seen the negative consequences of disregarding 11:25?
- -How have you seen the effectiveness of obeying 11:25?
- -How long do we need to keep stirring, meeting, encouraging one another?

Read Colossians 1:10-14

- -What is the motivating truth in 1:14?
- -What are the characteristics of a worthy walk in 1:10-13?
