

Discussion Guide for Revelation 13:1-10

1. Read Revelation 13:1-10 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

2. Truth: The tribulation is an awful time for unbelievers and also new believers. A smart person avoids the tribulation by following Jesus now and being sure that he is truly saved.

Read Matthew 7:13-20

What do we learn about a true saving relationship with Christ from the two gate illustration?

What are the evidences that a teacher or disciple has truly entered through the narrow gate of true saving faith and is on the road that leads to life?

Read Matthew 7:21-23

What are the two groups of religious people seeking entrance into the kingdom?

Which groups claim a saving connection to Jesus as their Lord?

How might those who are rejected by Christ on judgment day have been self-deceived during their life?

What is the pattern of life of those who are accepted by Christ?

How does 7:18-20 help us understand why they are accepted?

Read Matthew 5:20-6:4

What are some ways that we can be clearly recognized as those who consistently do the will of God?

Which group are you in? Are you sure and why?
