

## Discussion Guide for Revelation 14:6-13

### 1. Read Revelation 14:6-13 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

### Read Romans 3:19-20

What are the benefits and purpose of explaining God's unattainable moral standards to unbelievers?

Why might Ramadan be a great time for talking about God's unattainable moral standards?

How does it help them truly understand themselves?

How does it help them understand their relationship to God?

What are some other places in the Bible that you can share with an unbelieving friend to help them see God's moral standards and the seriousness of their sin?
