Are there any corrupting friendships that God is convicting you to end?

What are the other doors through which these influences enter our lives and homes?

What are some ways that we can shut the door on these influences to keep them away from us and our families?

Are there any doors of evil influence that God is convicting you to shut for yourself or your family?
