1. Read Revelation 1:9-20 and briefly review the sermon outline.

Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15

How does it make you feel to know that, despite your failures, you will still be graciously saved?

Read Revelation 1:4-6

How do Jesus's love for us change the way that we relate to Him and one another?

How does the fact that Jesus freed us from the power and penalty for sin change the way that we meet with temptation?

How does Jesus making us part of His kingdom change the way that we relate to God and to our fellow believers?

How does our role as priests change our relationship to God and unbelievers?
