

## Discussion Guide for Revelation 22:1-2

### 1. Read Revelation 22:1-2 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

**2. Truth: When finally arrive as God's people in God's perfect place, we will be completely free from sin's presence around and in us. As we struggle towards completed sanctification in eternity, God has given us all we need to wage a consistent and victorious war overcoming our own sin today.**

Read Romans 6:5-11

How does Jesus' death and resurrection serve as a picture of our salvation?

As spiritually new people, what is our new relationship to sin?

What actions or attitudes are often categorized by unbelievers as "addictions", "illnesses" or "predispositions" but that God explicitly calls sins?

What hope do these verses give a non-Christian who is struggling in sin?

What hope do these verses give us, as Christians, who are fighting sin?

Read Romans 6:12-14

What is the call to action in these verses?

How do the two actions in v.13 work together to win the fight?

How does grace empower you to keep on fighting?
