

Discussion Guide for Revelation 22:1-7

1. Read Revelation 22:1-7 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

2. Truth: Being ready for the rescue by Jesus before the tribulation (Rev. 3:16) is the Christian's source of eager anticipation (Heb. 9:28, 1 Thess. 1:9-10), stabilizing encouragement (1 Thess. 4:16-18), and transforming hope (Titus 2:11-15). This promise motivates us to godly living and laboring for Christ while we wait (Phil. 3:14-21).

Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

What are the exciting things that will happen at the moments Jesus comes to rescue us?

How does this give us encouragement and hope in the face of losing a Christian brother or sister?

Read Titus 2:11-14

What is our blessed hope?

For what purpose did Jesus redeem us?

What does the any-moment arrival of our redeemer train us to do?

What specific examples of faithfulness do we find in 2:1-10?

Which of these do you want to master as you wait for the Master?

With what Christian responsibility does God begin and end this chapter?

Who will you teach about Jesus' any-moment return this week?
