

Discussion Guide for Revelation 6:9-11

1. Briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Saturday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

2. **Truth:** Sometimes it feels like God is not answering and acting quickly enough. Despite our feelings, God's timing is perfect.

Read Matthew 6:25-34

1. What do the birds and the lilies teach us about God's care and provision for us?

2. What are the earthy anxieties that worry you the most?

3. What are the promises from God in this passage that we can hold onto instead of worrying?

4. Once we stop focusing on worry and begin to trust God, where does God want us to redirect our focus? Why does this make so much more sense?

Read Matthew 6:19-24

1. What is the connection between trusting God (6:25-34) and storing up treasures on earth?

2. What is the nature of earthly treasures?

3. What is the nature of heavenly treasures? What are some heavenly treasures and what activities can we do to store them up?

4. What is the call of 6:24? What steps can we take this week to obey?
