## 4) The Exalted Son: By Resurrection

Jesus being the exalted Son emphasizes that He was \_\_\_\_\_\_ as the Son, King and Savior of the world by resurrection

**A)** Jesus's exaltation includes both being restored to previous honor (John 17:4-5) and \_\_\_\_\_\_ to additional honor.

**B)** Promotional Honors Preached by the Apostles: #1 Name, King, Lord, Savior, Judge, Christ, Right Hand Man, Leader, Priest (Phil. 2:9-11, Rom. 1:4, Acts 10:36–43, Acts 2:32–36, Acts 5:30 w Heb. 2:9-17)

Challenge: God has all always existed but Jesus was "begotten"

**Answer:** Jesus was \_\_\_\_\_\_ from the dead by the Father in a declaration of His exalted Sonship.

*Jesus was the "only Son of God" by His Divine Nature* (*John 1:14, 1:18, 3:16, 4:18, 1 John 4:19*)

*Jesus was the "begotten Son of God" by His Resurrection* (*Rom. 4:1, Acts 13:32-33, Ps. 2:6–8, Heb. 1:1–14, Heb. 5:5 w/ 7:17*)
