

Worship the Son of God, Part 6

Four Aspects of Sonship (*Key Passage: Phil. 2:5-11*)

- 1) The Eternal Son: By Nature
- 2) The Incarnate Son: By Birth
- 3) The Proven Son: By Obedience
- 4) The Exalted Son: By Resurrection

Jesus being the exalted Son emphasizes that He was honored as the Son of God and King of the world by resurrection

Jesus's exaltation by resurrection includes both being restored to previous honor (John 17:4-5) and promoted to additional honor.

Challenge: God has all always existed but Jesus was "begotten"

Answer: Jesus was given life from the dead by the Father in a declaration of His exalted Sonship.

Jesus is the "only Son of God" by His Divine Nature
(John 1:14, 1:18, 3:16, 4:18, 1 John 4:19)

Jesus is the "begotten Son of God" by His Resurrection
(Rom. 4:1, Acts 13:32-33, Ps. 2:6-8, Heb. 1:1-14, Heb. 5:5)
