

Revelation 19:11-21

The Return of King Jesus

A) Jesus' Return and Kingdom are the Big Promise of the Bible

- 1) 1,500+ places in the Bible looking forward to the *promised* return and reign of Christ
(ex. Isaiah 9:6-7, Isaiah 11, Luke 1:31-33, Luke 12:31-32, Matthew 6:9-13, 2 Peter 1:3-11, 1 Corinthians 15:22-26)
- 2) Jesus' return signals the *promised* end of Satan and sin's domination of the earth & the *promised* return of all power to its rightful owner: King Jesus! (1 Corinthians 15:22-26)

B) The Return of King Jesus: The promise keeping God keeping His promises (Revelation 19:11-21)

- 1) Following King Jesus demands that we Hallelujah! God's whole offer (Revelation 19:11)
 Humbling His Enemies, Delivering His People,
 & Glorifying His Name
- 2) If anyone wants to understand 'God', Jesus is always the first person to seek
(Revelation 19:12-13, John 1:1-18, Hebrews 1:2-3)
- 3) Following Servant Jesus now encourages us that we will be beside King Jesus always
(Revelation 19:14, 19:7-8, 1 Thess. 4:17-18, Romans 8:15-17)
- 4) Prideful and rebellious people have no future with King Jesus (Revelation 19:15)
- 5) Following King Jesus requires embracing both the Lamb and the Lion (Revelation 19:15)
- 6) If you are not with King Jesus, you don't want an invitation (Revelation 19:17-18)
- 7) The world's scariest bad guys are a joke against the power of King Jesus
(Revelation 19:17-18)
